This year welcomed more than 1,000 students from high schools across Connecticut for a full day of hands-on exploration and career discovery in the trades.

The event brought together a wide range of exhibitors—many of them longtime partners—who continue to play a vital role in making this signature program possible year after year. Their ongoing commitment to workforce development was on full display, as they engaged directly with students, shared industry insights, and showcased the many rewarding pathways within construction and the skilled trades.

From interactive demonstrations to meaningful one-on-one conversations, students had the opportunity to experience the industry in action and envision their future within it. The enthusiasm throughout the day reflected both the growing interest in the trades and the dedication of CT ABC members to investing in the next generation.
